Sub:- Issue of income certificates - procedure  
for calculation of family income - in-  
structions - regarding -

Government, by order No. DPAR 30 SBC 80 dated 3-2-1981, have issued directions that for the purpose of determining whether a candidate belongs to backward community or backward class or special group, the family income stipulated in Appendix-(1) to the Government Order dated 4-3-1977, shall exclude the income of the candidate from his salary as local candidate on temporary basis and the amount of stipend received by him/her under Stipendiary Employment Scheme.

2. In spite of the above clear instructions, it has come to the notice of Government that some Revenue Officers have included the salary of local candidates and the stipend received under Stipendiary Employment Scheme, while issuing income certificates to the candidates. This has caused inconvenience to the local candidates/stipendiary graduates for applying to Government jobs reserved for backward class/community candidates.

3. All the Revenue Officers are hereby directed to adhere strictly to the instructions/directions issued in Government Order No. DPAR 30 SBC 80 dated 3-2-1981, while furnishing certificates to the local candidates/stipendiary graduates.
