CIRCULAR

Sub: Extension of time till 30-6-1983 for filing the applications for registration of occupancy rights under the provisions of Karnataka (R&C) Inam Abolition Act, 1955 Karnataka (Sandur Area) Inam Abolition Act, 1976 and Karnataka Certain Inam Abolition Act, 1977.

Under the various Inams Abolition Acts (1) The Karnataka (Religious and Charitable) Inam Abolition Act, 1955, (2) The Karnataka (Sandur Area) Inam Abolition Act, 1976 and (3) The Karnataka Certain Inam Abolition Act, 1977, occupants of agricultural lands are eligible for registration of their occupancy rights provided they file their applications within the time allowed for filing applications.

The above three Acts were amended and extension of time was granted upto 30-6-1981 for filing the applications for occupancy rights.

In Circular of even number dated 25th October 1982, instructions were given to the Divisional Commissioners, who are the Chief Controlling Officers to implement the provisions of Inams Abolition Acts and that in case of failure to file applications, the lands shall vest in Government and the lands so available shall have to be disposed of according to Rules relating to grant of lands.

It has been brought to the notice of the Government by the District Ryotha Association, Bellary that much hardship is being experienced by the ryots on account of such instructions and requested to stay further action in the matter. The Legislators of Bellary District are also urging Government to take immediate remedial measures to redress the hardship faced by the ryots.

Further it has been brought to the notice of Government that small holders of inam land are not aware of the implications regarding the non-filing of applications for registration of occupancy rights etc.

With a view to help these holders of inam lands the last date for filing the applications under the above said Acts is hereby extended upto 30th June, 1983.
