Government have recently taken a decision to waive the premium payable under Land Reforms Act by those ex-tenants who have been conferred with occupancy rights and whose total holding of 'D' class land including the former tenanted land, as owner, does not exceed 10 acres. While necessary steps are separately being taken to introduce the legislation in the ensuing Assembly session, it may take some more time for passing the legislation by both the Houses of the Legislature. The Government has decided to enforce the decision with immediate effect.

Hence the Deputy Commissioners, Assistant Commissioners and Tahsildars are directed not to collect the premium from those ex-tenants who have been conferred with occupancy rights and whose total holding as owner, including former tenanted land does not exceed 10 acres of 'D' class land, pending passing of necessary law in this regard.
