Sub:- Land Reforms - Instructions not to be  
move the Sub-Divisional Magistrates to  
take action under Sec.145 of Cr.P.C.  
in cases where applications of tenants  
for registration as occupants are pending  
before Tribunal - Issued -  
---

In Government letter No.RD 502 LRM 76 dt.5-8-1976, a copy  
of Circular No.3823 dt.12-7-1976 issued by the Inspector General  
of Police with regard to giving protection to the tenants under  
Karnataka Land Reforms Act was circulated to all the Police  
Officers for information and necessary action. Again in Circular  
No.RD 608 LRM 77 dt.28-12-1977, those instructions were re-  
iterated.

It has been brought to the notice of Government, that  
implementation of the decisions taken by the Tribunals is  
being sought to be obstructed by certain parties by moving  
applications under Sec.145 Cr.P.C.

While considering such applications, Government desire  
that it should be borne in mind that any action taken should  
not have the effect of defeating the implementation of the  
Land Reforms Act.
