

C I R C U L A R

It has come to the notice of Government that some of the Tahsildars are not accepting declarations under Section 66 of the Karnataka Land Reforms Act on the ground that they have not received instructions in the matter. The Declarations under this Section have to be submitted to the Tahsildar under the Act itself and no special orders empowering the Tahsildar are necessary in this behalf.

The Deputy Commissioners of Districts are requested to issue immediate instructions to the Tahsildars to receive the declarations filed before them under Sections 66, 79-A and 79-B of the Land Reforms Act and to issue acknowledgments to the declarants immediately the declarations are filed. The declarations may be entered chronologically in separate registers to be opened for declarations under each sections.

By the 10th of each month a report should be made to Government by the Tahsildar (with a copy to the Deputy Commissioner) giving the number of declarations registered in the preceeding month.
