CIRCULAR

Sub:- Withdrawal of exemption to linaloe
cultivated lands under Karnataka Land
Reforms Act, 1961 and further action reg.
Ref:- Government Notification No.RD/217/LRA/93
Dated 8.3.1994.

In Government Notification No.RD/217/LRA/93 dated
8.3.1994, published in the part IV of the Gazette dated 11.3.94
the exemption given to the Land used for Linaloe cultivation
under clause (vi) of Sub-Section(1) of Section 107 of Karnataka
Land Reforms Act, 1961 has been withdrawn by the Government
under Section 110. Hence the Land used for the cultivation of
Linaloe shall have to be construed as land used for agriculture
under the Land Reforms Act, 1961.

Some of the important provisions under sections
63, 66, 67, 74, 76, 77, 79, 80, 81, 82, 83 and 122A etc. of the
Karnataka Land Reforms Act, 1961 which are being made applicable
to agricultural lands are also to be applied to the lands used
for cultivation of Linaloe. The Revenue Officers, prescribed
authorities under the Act and Land Tribunals shall hence forth
identify such lands coming under the purview of the Karnataka
Land Reforms Act, 1961 and proceed as prescribed under the Act.

The Deputy Commissioners are requested to ensure proper
application of the provisions of Karnataka Land Reforms Act, 1961
to the cases pertaining to the lands used for cultivation of
Linaloe, by issuing suitable instructions to the Revenue
Officers, Tahsildars and Chairmen of Land Tribunals. The
progress achieved shall be reviewed by the Deputy Commissioners
in the monthly meetings of Revenue Officers of the District
and by the Divisional Commissioners during the meetings of the
Deputy Commissioners. The Divisional Commissioners shall submit
quarterly report to Government within two weeks after the
term of each quarter.

The proforma at Annexure - I, II & III are prescribed
for the review of progress at District and Divisional level
and for submitting report to Government respectively.
