C I R C U L A R

1. A Workshop on Land Reforms in Karnataka was organised by the Institute for Social & Economic Change, Bangalore under the sponsorship of the Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration, Musoorie and the Government of Karnataka from September 1-3, 1993. The workshop deliberated on the various themes in depth and came out with a set of recommendations.

2. One of the recommendations reads as follows:

1.12:- The Panchayat Raj Institutions should be involved in ~~implementation~~ of the various aspects of the Land Reforms Legislations.

3. Government have accepted the above recommendations. Therefore, all the Divisional Commissioners, Deputy Commissioners, Assistant Commissioners and the Tahsildars are instructed to involve the Panchayath Raj institutions in the implementation of the various provisions of the Land Reforms Act, with regard to concealed tenancy, farzi & hidden transactions, detection of surplus land, etc.,

4. The action taken on the above recommendation may be intimated to Government early.
