C I R C U L A R

Sub: Financial assistance for development and cultivation of declared surplus as a result of imposition of land ceiling -

The Government of India have formulated a scheme to give financial assistance to the assignees to whom surplus lands as a result of imposition of land ceiling would be assigned to take to efficient cultivation of the so assigned land by taking up development works like land levelling, land shaping, contour bunding etc. For this purpose, the required scale of investment is estimated to be of the order of Rs.500/- per hectare. Assistance of this order of which 50% will be outright grants would be made available. In respect of the surplus land falling within the districts covered by special programmes, like the Small and Marginal Formers and Agricultural Labourers Development Agencies Draught Prone Area Programme and Command Area Development Programme etc. the investment needs of the assignees are expected to be met by the said agencies.

The short term assistance by way of grants is also proposed to be given to help the assignees to meet their immediate requirements of Seeds, Organic manure, Chemical fertilizers, Pesticides, agricultural implements etc. as well as for their consumption requirements until the crops are harvested, at Rs.250/- per hectare per season. This grant will be available for the first two crop seasons which in most such cases are likely to be two years. A copy of the Government of India letter No.11-11/72-LRU. dated 27-8-1975 is enclosed herewith for ready reference.

The outlines of the above mentioned scheme may kindly be noted by all the Revenue Officers for guidance in future.
