
Circular

In Circular No. LD 422 LHM 75 dated 25.11.1975 instructions were issued to the Tribunals to endeavour to collect and assess evidence, which may substantiate the claim of tenant, by recourse to oral evidence, spot inspection and local enquiries, particularly with the actual cultivators of neighbouring fields, and if no such evidence is forthcoming, to examine whether such a person comes under the category of "deemed tenant" described in Sec. 4 of the Karnataka Land Reforms Act.

Instructions have also been issued to make all possible attempts to place on record the evidence collected in favour of the tenants before deciding the tenants' applications against them and that the Tribunals' orders should always be speaking orders discussing the evidence collected.

It is once again reiterated that the circular instructions issued in the matter previously should be scrupulously followed.
