CIRCULAR

Sub: Duties and functions of Tribunals and their office bearers - Further clarification issued regarding dispossessed tenants -

-:-

Government in their Circular No. RD 134 LRM 74 dated 4.7.1974 issued instructions regarding the duties and functions of Tribunals and their office bearers. The position with regard to the Tenancy Laws which were in force in the integrated areas and the provisions relating to surrender of tenancy thereunder were explained in the fourth paragraph. Paragraph 5 provided a brief summary of the effect of these provisions.

2. Government have further examined the position of the dispossessed tenants in the different areas with reference to section 7 of the Karnataka Land Reforms Act 1961, as amended in 1974, which provides for restoration of possession to tenants dispossessed after 10th September 1957.

3. For the sake of removal of doubts the penultimate paragraph (para 5) of the said Circular dated 4.7.1974 commencing with the words - "All the provisions mentioned above put together" and ending with the words, "This position should be brought to the specific notice of all the members of the Tribunal by the Chairman and the Secretary", is hereby ordered to be deleted.
