C I R C U L A R

Sub: Record of Rights - Tenancy particulars -  
Rectification of wrong entries.

In Government Circular No. RD 247 SST 72, dated 28th September 1973 as corrected by Corrigendum of even no Dated 17-10-1973, instructions were issued to all the Revenue Officers to scrutinise immediately all old Records of Rights and to take action to set right the unauthorised entries in view of the imminence of tenants becoming owners of the lands cultivated by them. 10 days notice was allowed to be given to the persons likely to be aggrieved by the corrections to prefer objections, if any.

It is however noticed that the Karnataka Land Revenue Rules provide for 30 days notice to the persons likely to be aggrieved to prefer objections, if any, to the correction of entries in Record of Rights. In view of this statutory provision 30 days' notice may be given in such cases.
