CIRCULAR

Sub: Regularisation of Unauthorised cultivation under section 94A of Karnataka Land Revenue Act, 1964 - Fixation of targets for disposal - Regarding.

1. Section 94A of Karnataka Land Revenue Act has been introduced to facilitate regularisation of unauthorised cultivation of Government land in the State and the rules also have been framed for the same. It is observed that though the legal provisions have been made for regularisation of unauthorised cultivation, the progress in this regard has so far been hasty and slow. Besides, monthly progress reports in this regard have not been furnished by the Districts.
2. Government is keen that the Scheme of Regularisation of Unauthorised Cultivation is implemented quickly and in the right spirit. In pursuance of the need to implement this scheme quickly, Government hereby fixes the following target for each District. The target given below in terms of regularisation of the extent of land shall be completed before 26.1.1992:

2. Bengaluru (Rural)	5,000-00
3. Shimoga	15,000-00
4. Chitradurga	6,000-00
5. Tumkur	10,000-00
6. Kolar	7,000-00
