NOTIFICATION

The draft of the following rules further to amend the Karnataka Land Revenue Rules, 1966, which the Government of Karnataka proposes to make in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 197 of the Karnataka Land Revenue Act, 1964 (Karnataka Act 12 of 1964) is hereby published as required under sub-section (1) of the said Section, for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration after expiry of thirty days from the date of its publication in the official Gazette.

Any objection or suggestion which may be received from any person in respect of the said draft by the State Government before the expiry of the period specified above will be considered by the State Government. DRAFT RULES

1. **Short title and commencement-**(1) These rules may be called the Karnataka Land Revenue(Amendment) Rules, 2000

2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. **Amendment of rule 43.-** In sub-rule (1) of rule 43 of the Karnataka Land Revenue Rules,1966 (hereinafter referred as said rules);

(i) for the word "Tahsildar" the word "Shirestedar" shall be substituted.

(ii) for sub-rule (3), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"(3) An appeal shall lie against the decision of such officer to the Assistant Commissioner incharge of the sub-division, whose decision shall be final".

3. **Amendment of rule 66:-** In rule 66 of the said rules, for the words "Tahsildar or any officer superior in rank to him" the words :Revenue Inspector or by any officer of the Revenue Department superior in rank to him"shall be substituted.

4. **Amendment of rule 69:-** In rule 69 of the said rules, for clauses(i) and (ii), the following shall be substituted, namely:-

"(i) by the Revenue Inspector or an officer equal or superior in rank to him or by the Tahsildar an appeal shall lie to the Assistant Commissioner; and

(ii) by the Assistant Commissioner, appeal shall lie to the Deputy Commissioner."
