

Sub: Clarification regarding mode of execution of the order passed by the Land Tribunal under the Land Reforms Act, 1961.

-:-

A doubt has been raised as to the mode of execution of the order passed by the (Land) Tribunal under the Land Reforms Act, 1961, particularly in the context of the exercise of the newly conferred interlocutory powers of the Tribunals, like issue of temporary injunctions appointment of receivership, etc.

According to Section 116(2) of the Land Reforms Act, 1961 (as amended), all orders passed by the Tribunal awarding possession or restoring the possession or use of any land shall be executed in the same manner as an order passed by a Revenue Officer under the provision of Karnataka Land Revenue Act, 1954. This position is brought to the notice of all concerned for necessary action.
