

C I R C U L A R

Sub:- Acknowledgement of applications under section 48-A of Karnataka Land Reforms Act -

It has come to the notice of Government that in some cases tampering of some Survey Nos. has been done during the period from the date of filing the applications to the date of hearing the case by the Tribunal resulting in disadvantage and detriment to the tenants who have filed applications under section 48-A of Karnataka Land Reforms Act.

All the Tahsildars/Special Tahsildars (Land Reforms) are requested to issue acknowledgement in the proforma enclosed in respect of applications and documents already filed before the (Land) Tribunal. Even the documents filed during the evidence stage by the tenants should be acknowledged. They should further see that no tampering of records take place in the offices. If any such mal-practices or irregularities are committed, Government will not hesitate to take severe action against the officials responsible for such acts. The Tahsildars/Special Tahsildars should exercise strict supervision and keep a close watch on the registration and disposal of applications filed by tenants.
