Sub: Reservation of lands vesting in the Government for Industrial Development under Section 77 sub-Section 3 of the Karnataka Land Reforms Act with the help of Karnataka Industrial Areas Development Board.

The Government have the power under Section 77, sub-Section 3, of the Karnataka Land Reforms Act to reserve any land vesting under the various provisions of the Act mentioned in Section 77, sub-Section(1). It has been decided that some of these lands should be so reserved for the Industrial Development of the State

The Government have already set up the Karnataka Industrial Areas Development Board under the Karnataka Industrial Areas Development Act, 1966, for the purpose of acquiring and making available land for the development of industries in the State. The Board has specialised knowledge to determine the utility of land for Industrial Development. It has, therefore, been decided that the Board will prepare a list of lands suitable for Industrial Development in various parts of the State and thereafter approach the Tahsildars of the Taluks concerned with a view to finding out whether some of these lands have vested in the State Government under the provisions of the Land Reforms Act and are available for reservation for public purpose under Section 77, Sub-Section 3, of the Act. If an verification it is found that such lands are so available, the Board may approach the Government which in turn can take action under the said section.

To facilitate the above process the Tansildars, Assistant Commissioners, Deputy Commissioners etc. are requested to extent all possible help and co-operation to the officers of the Karnataka Industrial Development Board in vertication of the availability of lands for Industrial Development in the State in the category of lands vested in the State Government under the Land Reforms Act.
