for filing applications and declarations-

The Mysore Land Reforms (Amendment) Act, 1973 and the Karnataka Land Reforms Rules, 1974 (provisional) have been published in the Karnataka Gazette Extraordinary dated 1.3.1974 and they have come into force from that date.

Pointed attention of the Revenue Officers who are charged with the task of implementation of the Land Reforms Programme is invited to the Sections 44, 48-A, 66 and 79B of the amendment act, 1973 which contain time bound action and they are requested to see that the time limits specified in the sections are brought to the notice of the agriculturists/landlords/ landowners and tenants concerned by wide publication in village chawadias, V.P. Offices, Taluk Board Offices, Taluk Offices and other conspicuous places concerned.

The provisions referred to above are briefly described below for ready reference of the Revenue Officers -

Under Sec.44 of the Land Reforms act as amended all tenanted lands except the lands permitted to be leased under Sec.5 have stood transferred to and vested in Government from 1.3.1974. The consequences following the vesting are given in detail in Chapter III of the said Act.

Section 48-A provides that every person entitled to be registered as an occupant under Sec.45 has to make an application to the Tribunal constituted under Sec.49 within six months from 1.3.1974.

The provision in Sec.66 requires every person holding 10 acres of A Class or B Class of land, 20 acres of C class of land and 40 acres of D class of lands to file before the Tahsildar

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Section 79-B prohibits holding of agricultural lands by certain persons, Co-operative Societies etc. with effect from 1.3.1974. Such persons, Co-operative Societies etc. who have held land have to furnish a declaration of the holdings to the Tahsildar within ninety days from 1.3.1974.

The Divisional Commissioners/Deputy Commissioners are also requested to ensure that wide publicity is given to the above provision by the subordinate Revenue Officers during their routine inspection of the Revenue Offices.
