CIRCULAR.

Sub:- Remittance of Rent or Govt. amount
by the Tenants - Mentioning of Head of
Account.

All lands held by or in possession of tenants as
on 1-3-1974 other than those held by them under leases
permitted under section 5 of the Karnataka Land Reforms
Act, 1961 have stood transferred to and vested in
Government from 1-3-1974. All rights, title and interest
vesting in the owners of such lands and other persons
interest in such lands have ceased, and these are vested
absolutely in the State Government free from all
encumbrances (Section 44).

Enquiries are being made as to the Head of Account
to which the rent payable to Government in respect of
such land vested in Government is to be deposited. The
Revenue Officers should advise the agriculturists
concerned to deposit the amt payable in respect of the
land vested in Government in the following Head of
Account:

- K. Deposits and Advances
(b) Deposits not bearing interest.
843. Civil Deposits - Revenue Deposits.

These deposits will be taken set off against the
premium payable to Government by the tenant who on
the orders of the Tribunal gets the occupancy rights
and that would help in reliving the burden of paying
to Government the accumulated arrears of premium.
If the person depositing the amount is ordered to be
not entitled to be registered as an occupant of the
land by the Tribunal then the amount deposited will be
treated as rent paid to Government for the land in
question.

The Revenue Officers have to get ready with
upto date village-wise lists of lands under lease
specifying the rent as prescribed in Section 8, in
respect of such lands from 1-3-74 and take
earnest steps for their recovery.
