A reference is invited to the Government Letter No. RD 20 LRM 75 dated 17.1.1975 addressed to the Deputy Commissioners of South Kanara / North Kanara / Shimoga and the Divisional Commissioners of Bangalore / Mysore / Belgaum Divisions, the contents of which may be perused at pages 272, 273 of the printed book on "Land Reforms", (collection of orders, circulars etc.) copies of which have been distributed to all the Revenue Officers.

Government desires that a hectic drive should be undertaken by the Tahsildars / Special Tahsildars, Assistant Commissioners/ Special Assistant Commissioners concerned to ensure that the public notices and the individual notices contemplated in Section 48(A)(2) of the Land Reforms Act are issued by 31.12.1975, in the Forms and in the manner prescribed in Rule 19 as amended, to as many applicants as are likely to get their cases taken up by the Tribunal within the next three months. This step is considered to be quite necessary in order to create an awakening among all the interested persons and to remove any apprehension among the tenants that their applications are not receiving due and prompt attention.
