SUBJECT:- Implementation of Karnataka Inams  
Abolition (Amendment) Act, 1979 -  
Transfer of cases involving tenancy  
to Land Tribunals.

The Karnataka Inams Abolition (Amendment) Act, 1979

(Karnataka Act No. 26 of 1979) has come into force with effect from 1-5-1979. The Act seeks to amend certain provisions of the Mysore Personal and Miscellaneous Inams <sup>Abolition</sup> Act, 1954 (Mysore Act 1 of 1955) and the Mysore (Religious and Charitable) Inams Abolition Act, 1955 (Mysore Act 18 of 1955). Pursuant to the amendments, cases for registration of occupancy rights under the aforesaid two Acts stand transferred to respective Taluka Tribunals constituted under Section 48 of Karnataka Land Reforms Act, 1961. Further the amendments of the two Acts provide for extension of time to file applications for registration of occupancy rights under the provisions of the two Acts in respect of Inam lands upto 31-12-1979.

The Special Deputy Commissioners for Abolition of Inams, Bangalore and Hassan and Special Deputy Commissioners of Districts incharge of Abolition of Inams in the Old Mysore Area (excluding the Bellary) are requested to prepare immediately the list of applications/cases pending before them in respect of both Personal and Miscellaneous as well as Religious and Charitable Inams involving registration of occupancy rights taluka-wise, hobli-wise and Village-wise within a month and forward them to the Secretaries of the concerned <sup>Land</sup> Tribunals of Taluks under intimation to the undersigned. The lists so prepared may be in duplicate and proper acknowledgements obtained from the Secretaries while handing over the applications/cases. Secretaries of the various

entertain fresh applications for registration of occupancy rights under both the Acts referred to above till 31-12-1979. ✓

Some of the cases which are now being transferred may include cases which have been remanded by the Karnataka Appellate Tribunal/High Court of Karnataka. These cases are to be decided in accordance with the directions issued by the respective Tribunal/High Court.

The Special Deputy Commissioners for Inams Abolition and Secretaries of Land Tribunals are requested to bear in mind the above instructions in view and take necessary further action immediately.
