CIRCULAR

Sub:- Land Reforms - Resumption of land by the
members of Armed Forces even before
release - Regarding -

In Government Circular No. RD 418 LRM 76 dated 19/22-2-1977 clarification was issued that a Soldier or a Seaman who has created a tenancy under the provision of Section 5 of the Karnataka Land Reforms Act was entitled to resume the tenanted land even while he was in service provided that he could arrange for personal cultivation within the meaning of Section 2A(II).

In this connection, it has been represented to Government that even now some of the Tahsildars/Special Tahsildars are not taking action to resume the land on behalf of the soldiers under Section 15(5) on the ground that a Soldier has not been released from duty. In this connection, the attention of all the Tahsildars/Special Tahsildars is invited to the amendment to Section 15, sub-section (3) clause (i), by replacing the word "within one year" by "at any time not later than one year" effected by Act 1/79. The Deputy Commissioners are requested to note that a Soldier in service in the Armed Forces could resume the tenanted land at any time not later than one year from the date on which he is released from the Armed Forces or is sent to the reserve, in view of the specific amendment effected now to the Act and issue suitable instructions to the Tahsildars/Special Tahsildars in this regard.
