Sub: Judgment by Tribunals - writing of -

:-:-

It has been brought to the notice of the Government that in some cases which have come before the High Court, the Tribunals concerned are found to have used printed or cyclostyled proforma to write their orders. It further appears from the orders passed by the Tribunals in these cases that the Tribunals have just filled in some relevant particulars pertaining to individual cases in the proforma. Government feel that it would be difficult to support such orders, when questioned, on the ground that the Tribunals concerned have not properly applied their minds to the facts of the case and have dealt with the question before them in a very formal and desultory manner.

All the Assistant Commissioners and Special Assistant Commissioners who are functioning as Chairmen of the Tribunals are hereby directed not to use printed or cyclostyled proforma to write their orders. The main body of the judgment (apart from the title page) should be written in hand or type written and should contain clear indication that the Tribunal has applied its mind to the case.
