Tahsildar's Special Monthly Report—Facts about Land Reforms

### CIRCULAR

No. RD 5 LRM 72, BANGALORE, DATED THE 11TH FEBRUARY 1972.

It is considered necessary to obtain special monthly reports from the Tahsildars on land reforms work in as concise and consolidated form as possible with a view to assess the progress made in the implementation of land reforms in each Taluk and to keep a talukwise record of basic progressive data for purposes of formulating future policy on land reforms and for providing, from time to time, the required manpower for implementation.

All the Tahsildars of Taluks are requested to send every month, starting from February, 1972, special monthly reports in the form enclosed. Four copies of the Forms are sent herewith. The report may be prepared in duplicate in pencil with carbon process. The original may be sent to the Government and the duplicate retained for office record. It is unnecessary to get the report typed and it is also unnecessary to send it with a separate forwarding letter, as a submission subscription has been provided at the end of the report. Where details such as remarks or reasons are found necessary, they may be mentioned on a separate sheet of paper to be attached to the report.

The report for each month should reach Government by the 10th of the succeeding month. This time limit should be strictly adhered to by all the Tahsildars.
