CIRCULAR

Sub: Land Reforms - Monthly Progress Reports under Quick Reporting System - furnishing correct information - regarding.

Ref: Circular No.RD 43 LRS 76 dated 10-9-76.

It is observed that the monthly progress reports under Quick Reporting System received from the Divisional Commissioners contain a number of discrepancies. Detailed instructions as to the procedure to be followed in furnishing the required information right from the Tribunal has been given in Circular dated 10-9-76 referred to above. All the concerned Officers are requested to follow the procedure laid down in the above said Circular and to note the following further clarification while preparing monthly progress reports under this system:

1. The Secretaries of the Tribunals should send cumulative figures (i.e. progress achieved from the inception of Land Reforms work upto the end of reporting month) under all columns except under Columns T₁, T₂, & C₁ which may vary according to the receipt and disposal of cases. They have to note again that the figures for the reporting month shall not be less than the figures of the previous month in respect of cumulative figures. They should send the report to the Deputy Commissioners concerned by 3rd of the month positively after due verification and check-up.

2. The Deputy Commissioners should compile the reports received from Tribunals after comparing the reports with the previous month reports. If any tribunal fails to send the report within the due date, the report may be compiled/taking previous month's figures, in respect of that tribunal and action may be taken against the concerned defaulting officer/official. The Deputy Commissioners should send the report to the concerned Divisional Commissioners by 5th of every month and they need not send the report to the Government directly.

3. Similarly the Divisional Commissioners should compile and send the report to Government by 7th of every month after duly compared with the previous month's figures sent by the Deputy Commissioners.

The above instructions shall be followed strictly while preparing reports under this system so that the compilation and analysis would be meaningful and effective.
