Sub: Timely submission of Parawise remarks,  
Records etc., to the Government Advocate  
concerned - Further instructions regarding.

Ref: Circular No. RD 40 LGW 88, dated 6.12.1988.

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In the Circular cited above, all the Revenue Authorities including the Divisional Commissioners, Deputy Commissioners, Assistant Commissioners and Tahsildars were instructed to furnish all the relevant details, Parawise remarks or Records as the case may be to the Government Advocate concerned quickly, whenever it is required, so as to facilitate him to defend the interests of Government. It was also instructed that Court cases must be responded to on top priority.

2. It has been brought to the notice of Government by the Advocate General that the Revenue Authorities at the Field level are not quickly responding to the requests from the Government Advocate concerned for submission of Parawise remarks or records in order to facilitate the Advocate concerned to prepare Statement of Objections to be filed in the High Court. It is noticed that such luke-warm response is very common in the cases relating to extraction of valuable minerals, resulting in Government losing the case even when it had a strong case to put-forth that the quarrying was illegal. This is a very serious matter amounting to negligence and dereliction of duty on the part of the Field Officers. Government will be constrained to take appropriate disciplinary action if the Revenue Authorities continue to display such an attitude towards such important cases.

3. It is once again instructed that the Divisional Commissioners/Deputy Commissioners/Assistant Commissioners/Tahsildars and other Revenue Authorities shall give top priority to Litigation cases pending in the High Court and other lower Courts and ensure that the interests of the Government does not suffer. If it comes to the notice of Government that the interests of Government in a particular case has suffered due to the negligence of the Revenue Authorities then suitable disciplinary action will be initiated.
