NOTIFICATION

G.S.R. Whereas the Central Govt. is of opinion that it is necessary and expedient in the public interest to exempt certain persons and classes of persons and exclude certain descriptions of arms and ammunition from the operation of all or some of the provisions of the Arms Act, 1959 (54 of 1959).

Now, therefore, in ~~xxx~~ exercise of the powers conferred by section 41 of that Act, the Central Government hereby exempts the person of persons from a country notified by the Special Organising Committee, IX Asian Games, Delhi, 1982, coming to India in connection with participation in the Shooting events in the forthcoming IX Asian Games to be held in Delhi in 1982, from the operation of sections 3 and 10(1) of the Arms Act, 1959 (54 of 1959).

Provided that the exemption hereby granted shall be subject to the following further conditions, namely:-

- a) it shall not be deemed to render lawful the import of arms or ammunition through the medium of post office,
 - b) the possession and carrying of arms and ammunition by the person or persons shall be subject to a permit to be issued by the licensing authority in such proforma as may be prescribed by the Central Government,
 - c) The persons or classes of persons exempted shall.
 - i) unless specifically exempted by the Central Government by notification in the Official Gazette, register in such manner and at such place as the Central Government may prescribe from time to time any firearm or ammunition in respect of which the exemption has been granted;
 - ii) render such statistical information about different description of arms and ammunition in respect of which the exemption has been granted in such proforma, if any, as may be required by the Central Government,
 - iii) whenever any arms or ammunition in respect of which exemption is granted is lost or stolen, forthwith report the occurrence of such loss or theft together with the details of the articles lost or stolen at the nearest police station.
