NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the State Government is of the opinion that having regard to the prevailing conditions in the State of Karnataka, it is expedient in public interest that distribution, acquisition, possession or carrying of double or multi-bladed sharp or pointed weapon be regulated.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Arms Act, 1959 (No.54 of 1959) read with Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No.GSR 1309 dated 1<sup>st</sup> October, 1962, the State Government hereby directs that the said section shall apply from the date of publication of this notification in the Karnataka Gazette to all places in the State of Karnataka in respect of distribution, acquisition, possession or carrying of double or multi bladed sharp or pointed weapon except in religious institution as defined in section 2 (E) of the Religious Institutions (Prevention of Misuse) Act, 1988 (Act No.11 of 1988) and in traditional religious functions and religious procession where such weapon is customarily used.
