CIRCULAR.

As a Taluk Magistrate, you are expected to anticipate incidents which are likely to result in law and order problem in your jurisdiction and take remedial measures to meet the said situation. While doing so, it is your primary duty to inform immediately the District Magistrate such incidents which pose a threat to law and order and the precautionary steps taken by you at the local level. For one reason or the other such reports anticipating law and order problem or even after occurrence of incident are not being sent to the District Magistrate. Therefore, it is hereby instructed that you keep the District Magistrate informed of important incidents/events touching upon law and order and other serious incidents like fire accident, natural or un-natural calamities etc.

If the incident is of a serious/affecting the public, it is the duty of the Taluk Magistrate to inform the District Magistrate immediately over telephone and the action taken by you in the matter. It is not however, possible to give you the list of incidents which result in law and order problem and which require your immediate attention by way of giving relief to the victims of such calamities and it is for you to consider the incidents which require your immediate attention and the attention of the District Magistrate.
