NOTIFICATION

Whereas the Central Government is of opinion that it is necessary to acquire the evacuee properties specified in the schedule hereto annexed in the States of Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Orissa, Punjab, Haryana, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Kerala, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Union Territory of Delhi for a public purpose, being a purpose connected with the relief and rehabilitation of displaced persons including payment of compensation to such persons.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 12 of the Displaced Persons (Compensation and Rehabilitation) Act, 1954 (44 of 1954), it is notified that the Central Government has decided to acquire and hereby acquires the evacuee properties specified in the Schedule hereto annexed.

SCHEDULE

All evacuee properties in the States of Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Orissa, Punjab, Haryana, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu, Karnataka, Kerala, Rajasthan, Uttar Pradesh and Union Territory of Delhi which have been allotted to the share of custodian in partition or have been vested in the Custodian under section 11 of the Evacuee Interest (Separation) Act, 1951 as a result of adjudication by the Competent Officer under the provisions of the said Act upto 30th June, 1983 or which have otherwise vested in the Custodian as a result of extinguishment of the mortgage under Sub-Section (2) of Section 9 of the said Act, upto 30th June 1984, and in respect of which no appeals have been filed, and if filed, have been rejected by the Appellate Officer.
