In Circular No. GWD 788C 72, dated 4-4-1972, it has been directed that all concerned officers should scrupulously follow the instructions issued from time to time in the matter of removal of untouchability and that they would be personally held responsible to ensure adequate protection to Harijans against any kind of discrimination arising out of untouchability. It has been further directed that they should take prompt action suo motu in all instances where the practice of untouchability comes to their notice.

In spite of several instructions issued, instances are still being brought to the notice of Government regarding practice of untouchability by way of discrimination arising out of ~~of /

of /~~ in serving food in hotels, entry into hotels and barber shops, etc.

Government, once again, impress on all the concerned the necessity to take steps to ensure adequate protection to Harijans against any kind of discrimination arising out of untouchability and they would be held personally responsible for failure to take adequate steps in this behalf.


