NOTIFICATION

The Government of Karnataka in Notification No. SWD 5 SBR 76 dated:26.3.1976 have extended the Karnataka Prohibition of Beggary Act 1975 (Karnataka Act 270 of 1975) to the following corporations / municipal areas, where Beggary Relief Centres are functioning with required infrastructural facilities:-

- a) Bangalore city corporation
b) Mysore city corporation
c) Mangalore city corporation
d) Hubli-Dharwad city corporation
e) Belgaum city corporation
f) Gulberga city corporation
g) Shimoga municipality
h) Davanagere municipality
i) Bellary municipality
j) Bijapur municipality

And whereas the Government of Karnataka are satisfied that suitable facilities exist for the relief of the beggars of that area.

Now, Government in exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (3) of Section 1 of the Karnataka Prohibition of Beggary Act, 1975 to the entire State of Karnataka with direction that the beggars arrested in the following districts should be transferred to the existing destitute relief centres shown against the centre and the Government appoints the 28th August 1997 as the date in which the said Act shall come into force.
