C I R C U L A R

SUB: Expeditious disposal of cases of regularisation of unauthorised cultivation under Section 94A of the Karnataka Land Revenue Act, 1964-Instructions regarding.

.....

It is observed that in spite of the fact that the Scheme of Regularisation of Unauthorised Cultivation under Section 94A of the Karnataka Land Revenue Act came into force over a year ago, the disposals under this Scheme are very poor. The Taluk Level Committees in almost all the taluks have also been constituted and such Committees have started functioning for about 8 months now but the disposal of cases by them is unsatisfactory. This is in spite of repeated instructions from the Government to take up disposal of such cases in right earnest quickly. In most of the taluks poor disposal is because of irregular sittings by the Committees.

In the circumstances, it is hereby instructed that the Taluk Level Committees for Regularisation of Unauthorised Cultivation on Government lands, shall henceforth conduct regular sittings on every Monday of the week and dispose of cases as per Rules. If Monday happens to be a Holiday then on the next working day the Committee shall necessarily conduct the meeting and dispose of cases. It is also hereby instructed that if any Member of the Committee is found to be irregular in attending the meetings then Government will not hesitate in removing him/her from the Committee. Three continuous absentions will entail removal of one's Membership. Government expects disposal of atleast 25 cases in each sittings.
