
CIRCULAR

Sub: **Providing of copy of RTC to Village Accountant
after mutation on Bhoomi – reg.**

In the old manual system of maintenance of RTCs, after every mutation the Village Accountant used to round the old owner and write the new owners name next to the rounded entry. In new system of Bhoomi, the handwritten records are not valid and Village Accountants are not supposed to make any correction or modification on computerised RTCs.

To ensure that Village Accountants always have the full set of current RTCs, the Shirastedar should provide to Village Accountants, copies of such RTCs which undergo mutation or any other change. It may be noted that if Village Accountants are not provided with new RTCs after mutation then Village Accountants will end up having old RTCs in respect of mutated RTCs which is not at all desirable. A separate proforma for maintaining various mutation transactions on Bhoomi is being prescribed. That proforma would provide for a column where Village Accountants will sign after they get the copy of mutated RTCs.
