CIRCULAR

Sub: Supervision of correction of checklist process by
Revenue Inspector, Shirastedars regarding.

Ref: 1) Letter No. RD 28 MRR 2001 dated 29th June 2001.

2) Circular No. RD 28 MRR 2001 dated 19th May 2001.

Vide letter at above reference (1), it was stressed that before the corrected checklist by Village Accountants is handed over, data entry agency, Revenue Inspector, Shirastedar, Tahsildar and Assistant Commissioners shall do test check of 40%, 30%, 20% and 5% and would sign the RTC which they have checked. These directions were issued as it was noted that in absence of such supervision, the Village Accountants were not doing the checking properly and after final print outs were given there were another round of corrections again leading to delay and more cost. In this regard, the attention of district administration is invited to Circular at ref (2) where it was clearly indicated that any such cost incurred will have to be made out of the salaries of the concerned and not from the Government funds.

In some of the recent inspections it has been noted that the directions of the Government regarding checking of checklists by superior officers is not being followed. It is re-iterated that Government will take serious action and even take disciplinary action against the concerned for not checking the corrected checklist as per the guidelines vide letter at ref 1 above.
