CIRCULAR

Sub: Data entry and subsequent mutations - reg.

Ref: Circular No RD 28 MRR 2001 Dated 23rd July 2001

In most of the taluks the data entry work is in progress. As and when the data entry process is over, the print outs are to be taken and are to be checked by Village Accountants. The print outs are to be corrected by comparing with RTCs for the year 2001-2002 in case the data entry is for the year 2001-2002. (As on today there are no places where data entry is being done for 2001-02 as the crop details for 2001-02 are still not available).

As the data entry is for the year 2000-01 then the RTC print outs should be compared only with the RTCs as they existed on the last day of the 2000-01 revenue year which happens to be 30.6.2001. In all these taluks where data entries are done for the year 2000-01, the data has to be updated for the year 2001-2002. In respect of such taluks Deputy Commissioners will have to get a list of mutations effect after 1.6.2001 till date. Such mutations will not be directly incorporated into the database, but will be got done through special software to be provided by NIC. However corrections and updations in the print out till 30.6.2001 will have to be corrected using the corrections software already provided. In this regard, please read the Circular at reference (1) above where it was clearly mentioned that mutation only upto 30th June 2001 are to be incorporated into the database.

It is not very difficult to understand why this strategy is adopted. If the RTC data is for the year 2000-01 which includes yearly cultivation particulars of that particular year and if the mutations which are effected in the year 2001-02 (i.e. after 30.6.2001) are directly corrected then the 2000-01 data of those RTCs will be over written with 2001-02 data and therefore data of 2000-01 will be lost. Hence in such a situation one will find the name of owners who get the Khata in 2001-2002 in the RTCs of 2000-01 (also containing other yearly details pertaining to year 2000-01) which is logically absurd.

The software to be provided by NIC would ensure that the updations done through that software would not be over-write 2000-01 data by 2001-02 data but

would push 2000-01 data separately into another database. When the print out of 2000-01 is taken then the owner of the 2000-01 will appear in the print out and wherever the print out of 2001-2002 are required, the owners of to 2001-2002 would only appear.

To summarise the following actions will be taken :

1) If the data entry is done for the year 2000-01:

- a) Correct RTC print outs by comparing with the RTCs as they existed on 30.6.2001.
- b) Make a list of mutations effected after 30.6.2001 (i.e. for the year 2001-2002) till date and update these names using separate software to be provided soon by the NIC.
- c) In case, the mutations executed after 30.6.2001 have already been entered into the RTC of 2000-01 that the data entry process at Data Entry Agencies premises or through the correction software after operationalisation (in contradiction to clause (a)), the list of those survey nos. may be prepared. The old owners in these survey nos. will have to be entered in history database using a special software to be provided by NIC.


2) If the data entry is done for the year 2001-02

- a) Correct the data with the RTC book as they exist on date of operationalisation.
