Sub: Putting of notice boards in front of Bhoomi kiosks - reg

While the scheme of Bhoomi is now operationalised in nearly all taluks, it is observed that many of the taluks farmers who approach taluk offices are still ignorant of the procedures for getting their land records or getting mutation to their land records. Thus there is a need for publicity efforts by District Administration. To start with, Deputy Commissioners are advised to put notice boards in Kannada in all the taluk offices covering the details, which are annexed to this note. Expenditure in this regard can be met out of contingency revenue expenditure released @ Rs.25,000 per taluk.
