## CIRCULAR

Sub: Updation of crop details for the year 2001-02 under the scheme of Computerisation of Land Records in operationalised taluks where scheme of Computerisation of Land Records has been operationalised.

The scheme of Computerisation of Land Records has been operationalised in more than 70 taluks in various districts in the state. The crop data in all these taluks are now available for the year 2000-01. While the computerised system ensures online updation of mutations it still depends upon batch updation for crop updation. This is because the crop details are available only during September-December of a particular year. These details can be fed into computers only during these months and after these details are seen in the field, collected and reported by Village Accountants.

As many parts of the state are reeling under drought and as September is soon approaching it is very necessary that crop details are updated on the computer system and immediately be attempted as per Circular No. RD 28 MRR 2001 date 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2001. As the handwritten records have been banned, Village Accountants cannot write into these computerised records. Accordingly, a form has now been devised which will be used by Village Accountants to enter crop details of various survey numbers of the villages for which he is responsible. The crop details will be written in these forms for only those survey no. where the crops have changed from the previous year i.e. 00-01. For those survey numbers where the crop and extent of the crop has remained the same, Village Accountants may not make any entries in the form being supplied to them as Bhoomi will be able to copy crop details in respect of such survey numbers from the previous year.

The form is attached to the Circular. It may be noted that crop details will have to be written for each cultivator separately in respect of survey number. For ex- If there are

4 cultivators in a survey number then the crops for all these 4 cultivators will have to be written separately. An example is indicated below:

Village : Magadi

Survey No. 10/2A

Cultivator's Name	Crop
Channappa	Ragi Paddy
Ramappa	Sunflower Jawar Ragi
Rajanna	Ragi
Vanjundappa	Groundnut

However if cultivator details of only 3 cultivators has changed out of 4, then the new crop details of only 3 owners may be mentioned. The fourth owner crop details are not mentioned.

These forms will then be taken by the Village Accountants in person to the computer centre and crop details will be got updated. Forms can be printed locally at your end.

In non- operationalised taluks, the new details would be with in the manual books as was done in earlier year.
