CIRCULAR

Sub: Entry of notice served date in objection entry – reg.

As per the Karnataka Land Revenue Act, any objection to a mutation has to be preferred within 30 days for the date of last served notice. This date is only known to the Village Accountants (or Revenue Inspectors) who serves the notice in the field.

As per the existing Bhoomi processes, the data entry operator is also required to fill in the notice served date. This has been creating problems in the field. The Bhoomi process is therefore being changed. In future version of Bhoomi, this data would be required in Revenue Inspectors screen. The Revenue Inspectors, whenever he visits taluk office, would also clear objection entries pending for his approval. He would ensure that he has details of notice served dates for all on going mutation processes when he visits taluk office.

The instructions in this Circular may please be communicated to all the Revenue Inspectors and Village Accountants.
