CIRCULAR

Sub: Handling of objections on new Bhoomi system – reg

Under the new Bhoomi dispensation objections are to be received in the taluk office. Immediately after they are received, it may happen that while Revenue Inspector is conducting the enquiry for acceptance of a mutation or otherwise, he may not be aware of objections received in taluk office. In such case if any mutation order is passed in the field by the Revenue Inspectors, it may not be proper and can be challenged in the higher court. It is therefore necessary that before any mutation order is passed by the Revenue Inspectors in the field, he would invariably check whether any objections have been received in the taluk office. In case of any objections he would obviously not proceed with the mutation order and shall put those cases in the disputes register.

It clearly is the responsibility of the Revenue Inspectors to ensure that before any order is passed by the Revenue Inspectors in the field no objections have been received in the taluk office or by the Village Accountants. If he passes mutation order without confirming the objections if any received in the taluk office, such mutation orders would not be implemented on the Bhoomi system and the Revenue Inspector shall than be subject to disciplinary action.

In such eventuality Tahsildar would have to get the mutation entry made by Revenue Inspector in the mutation register cancelled and closed by putting a stamp in red ink clearly indicating as follows: "Mutation order cannot be implemented as objection(s) have been received"

Apart from Tahsildar taking action to cancel such entry in the mutation register, he shall also propose disciplinary action against Revenue Inspectors for not ascertaining objections received before passing mutation orders.
