CIRCULAR

Sub: Deputation of field Village Accountants to
Bhoomi centres – reg.

More than 800 Village Accountants have been trained by the Government for working on Bhoomi. They have been actively involved in day to day activities of the centre. However, many other Village Accountants and Village Accountants Association have represented to Government that all other Village Accountants should also be given chance to enable them to get familiarized in the working of Bhoomi.

It is therefore suggested that every month about 10 Village Accountants should be deputed to Bhoomi centre for 2 days each to study functioning of Bhoomi. Suitable directions may please be given to all Tahsildars and may be discussed by Deputy Commissioners in their revenue officers meeting every month.

The deputation would be would be not exceeding 2 Village Accountants at the same time for 2 days each. This deputation would help them in getting exposed to details of Bhoomi and giving them a sense of involvement in the whole process. Some of them who feel to be further involved in the process can then be trained on working on Bhoomi if found suitable.
