CIRCULAR

It has been repeatedly stressed that for the safety of the data it is very essential to follow these principles.

1. To have sufficient capacity SCSI hard disk to mirror the data so that in case of failure of one hard disk other hard disk can take over.
2. To take daily back up of RTC and image database.

In one taluk recently, the hard disk crashed and mirrored hard disk was not in place. This resulted into loss of data. While steps have been taken to recover from such loss, needless to say it requires huge efforts.

It may be stressed that such failure takes place because of non compliance with the technical advises of the government for which District Administration would alone be responsible.

Deputy Commissioners are requested to ensure that all your taluks have 2 SCSI hard disk of enough capacity on server and daily back up of the RTC and image database is taken regularly without fail.

Deputy Commissioners are also requested to comply with the advice in Circular No. RD 12 MRR 2000 dated 20th December 2002 by ensuring that the copy of the database is sent to the Government on CD before 7th of every month without fail.
