CIRCULAR

Ref: G.O.No. RD 62 MRR 2000 dated 19.4.2001

Vide G.O. at reference above, Government had prescribed user charges of Rs.15 for provision of free RTC from the Bhoomi kiosk which has been set up in different taluk centres. Many a times, RTC of a single survey number may have large number of joint or multiple owners. In some cases, other rights and liabilities or diary no. (in Belgaum division) may be very large in number. Any of these factors may result into RTC of a single survey no. requiring multiple pages to print.

As the user charges fixed are R.15 per RTC, Tahsildars should charge Rs.15 for RTC of every survey no, irrespective of number of pages it gets printed on. It has come to the notice of Government that in some taluks Tahsildars are charging extra money for subsequent pages of the same RTC. This is in gross violation of Government order. Irrespective of number of pages, RTC of a particular survey no. occupies, farmers shall be charged only Rs.15. This may be brought to the notice of all concerned. Cases where any extra money is demanded from farmers over and above Rs.15 per RTC shall be viewed very seriously by the Government.
